

- About these Files -

Most of the current publications provided at jw.org now have page links with the “Inherit Zoom” setting, while most of the links in the older publications have a specific zoom setting like “Fit Page”. All of the links and bookmarks in the PDF’s here have been changed to the setting of “Inherit Zoom” instead of a custom setting, this way when the reader clicks a link it opens the page in the same page-view size that the reader is using so the reader doesn’t have to resize it to their viewing preference each time they click a link. (If I missed any, please let me know.)

Links have been added to the line items on the Contents page(s) for the majority of brochures here (if they have contents pages). When new publications come out, contents page links will be added to those too. Links have also been added to the pictures and references on the back pages of the Watchtower and Awake! periodicals that have them, and other areas where a link would be helpful like the pictures on the inside cover of the Revelation Climax book.

For the bound volumes the individual cover pages on the cover page are also links.

Since most of the PDF’s here of larger size have links on their Contents pages it is not necessary for them to have an extensive list of Bookmarks. Instead, a single bookmark has been added for the Contents page(s), and any other notable items not listed on the Contents page. This way, if the reader wants to move to a different location in the document they can just click the Contents page link and then click the desired link from there.

On 01-11-15 I went back and added to the front cover of newer books a link to the contents page. That way when you open a book, just tap or click the front cover to be taken to the contents page. (Thanks for the idea Ian! - If I miss any, please let me know.)


Helpful hint for PDF's:

In Windows use the keyboard shortcut *Alt+Left Arrow* (Alt+←) to return to the previous page after clicking a link.


On Macs use *Command+Open Square Bracket*: Command+[

In the publications that come with links the clickable areas of the links are small and only cover some of the text, so they have been enlarged for easier clicking. See the sample images below.

Also: Some PDF's at jw.org have very large pages for some reason. For instance page 4 of the February 1, 2014 Watchtower is 7,325 KB in size, while the average page size is less than 100 KB. This page was reduced down to 93 KB. Other pages with a similar extreme size in other periodicals have also been drastically reduced in size. (If I missed any please let me know.)

2013 Bible

Links have been added to the scripture references in the 20 questions at the front of the bible (*An Introduction to God's Word*).

Chapter links have also been added to each of the "Outline of Contents" that precede each book of the bible. (the official version @ jw.org now has these links)

Clicking any of the outlines will open to the page that that chapter begins on, the exceptions being chapter one if it is on the same page as the outline, and 2nd John, 3rd John, and Jude since those books are so short. Using the Outline links is also a quick way to get to a particular chapter. You click on the Book Names bookmark and the book you want, then the desired chapter in the Outline of Contents list.

The links on page 5 were also enlarged for easier clicking. And a field on page 2 has been added so you can enter your name. All links have also been changed from "Fit Page" to "Inherit Zoom" so your viewing zoom won't change when you click a link.

Version 2 is the same except the maps, timelines, and pictures at the back have been juxtaposed.

Web Links

For periodicals that have references to pages at jw.org, web links have been created for them if they do not already have links. If a referenced publication is viewable at jw.org then a link is created to take you there. If the publication is not viewable on jw.org but is available at wol.jw.org, then that link is provided instead.

Where did the publications go?

I move publications from prior years out of the /PDF folder into the "*Old Publications*" folder.

Definitions

Juxtaposed = These pages are placed side-by-side so the images that are split across two pages show as one page without a seam in the middle.

Scriptures = The scriptures have been embedded in these PDF's. Hover your mouse over a scripture reference and the text will display. If the referenced text is too large for the pop-up window to display, the scripture reference is a clickable link instead, which takes you to additional pages at the end of the publication to read the text. A link to return to the original page is provided there.

Larger Pictures = Some of the publications provided at jw.org have digitally cropped pages which cut off the edges of many of the pictures. These PDF's have been un-cropped so that the entire picture may be seen.

With Audio = Audio has been Embedded in these PDF's, thus the larger size. Click the button at the beginning of each chapter to hear it read to you. You need Adobe Reader (free) to hear the audio.

with web content = The articles referenced within these periodicals have been downloaded from jw.org and added to the end of the periodical. Though some of the items can be downloaded in PDF format, others cannot. And though those can be printed to PDF, the result is not particularly attractive, and at times has flaws such as text in front of images. These articles are therefore created from the web content. The content is added to these periodicals: (1) for those who want to view them at a time when they do not have internet access and therefore cannot view the referenced material. (2) for those who lack the skills to find the content for themselves. (3) to future proof them.

Plus = Articles that are included in the standard edition Watchtowers, but are not in the Simplified editions, have been added to the end of these Simplified Watchtowers.

Added Pictures

In the folder *Publications Without Pictures* are a set of PDF's that were released by the WTB&TS without images in them. The pictures have been scanned and added to those PDF's and placed with the rest of the PDF's. This creates a much higher quality PDF than just scanning a hardcopy since the text in the official PDF is crisp and clear while scanned text is blurry. A few of these have since been released at jw.org with their images intact, so those have been replaced with the official PDF's.

Newest Files

To organize the files from newest to oldest, click "Filetime" at the top of the page. Just as in Windows, the folders will reorganize separately and stay at the top, with the individual files reorganized below. To go back to alphabetical order click "Filename".
