Pastor Russell wrote and published six volumes of Studies in the Scriptures, and shortly after his death the Seventh Volume of the series was issued, the latter more particularly explaining the prophecies of Ezeklel and Revelation and proving how the unrighteous ecclesiastical systems have grown up in the earth and oppressed the people. This volume also points that Messiah's Kingdom is near at hand and that soon indescribable blessings will flow out to mankind.

Russell pointed out from the Bible that God had granted to the Gentiles a lease of power which would legally end in 1914, and that then the nations would become angry and God's wrath would come; that a great international war would begin at that time and would be followed by greater trouble, and that the trouble would usher in Messiah's Kingdom of righteousness, which would be the desire of all nations. Long ago he showed that it would be impossible for the United States to keep out of that war. The facts, now well known by every man, prove the correctness of Pastor Russell's interpretation of the Bible. His exposition of Scripture has greatly angered the majority of clergymen, because it shows that their teachings in the past have been out of harmony with the Word of God; and if he is correct in his interpretation of the Bible teachings, their position as clergymen must soon come to an end. The clergy were challenged to show the people that these Scriptural interpretations are wrong, or to join in explaining them to the people and thus to help in leading them into greater light and happiness. This they failed to do. They had no answer to the clear exposition of Scripture given by Pastor Russell and those who joined with him in the work.

About the same time the President of the Association addressed a great mass meeting at Los Angeles, Cal., one of the leading papers of that city ministerial alliance waited upon that paper with a view to preventing further publication of the Bible truths proclaimed by the International Bible Students Association. The clergy failed in this mission. A few days later, certain officers swooped down upon the Bible Students' headquarters took possession of their various publications, including Bibles and hymn books, and took them away. PERSECUTION IN GERMANY

To show a well-organized effort on behalf of the clergy to persecute these Bible Students, we see their activities have not been confined to our country alone, but to many countries. For a number of years the International Bible Students Association has maintained an office in Germany and in many other foreign countries. A paper in Copenhagen, Denmark, recently published the following:

"A Warning Against the Millennium Sect

"The Consistory of Kiel (Holstein, Germany) is calling the attention of the (Lutheran) priests to the activities carried on by the Millennial sect, which calls itself 'Watch Tower Bible and Tract Society,' and also 'Bible Students Association.' The Imperial War Department has recently requested us to keep a watchful eye on the activities of this sect, which con-sist in selling the writings of its founder, the recently deceased Pastor Russell, of Brooklyn, North America, in untiring propaganda work, accomplished with American money. The Consistory does, therefore, call the priests' attention to this sect and requests that they take action against it and report to the Consistory their observations of its dangerous activities."

"A scapegoat has been found for the recent reverses in Italy in the person of Pope Benedict XV., and one of the leading English papers does not hesitate to accuse him of having turned from a passive Austrophil into an active worker for the Austrian, as against the Italian, cause. In a long editorial in the London Morning Post the Vatican and all its works are roundly denounced. The London Tory or-gan says: 'The time has come when it is necessary that the Allies should consider with some care what is their position in relation to the Vatican. That the recent Italian reverse was largely due to the influence of treacherous representations disseminated among the Italian armies is known; that the Vatican was implicated in that propaganda is also known; and the result was a disaster so grave that its effects cannot yet be measured. Since the beginning of the war the Vatican, in so far as political action is concerned, has maintained an attitude which, as it was temporarily neutral, was spiritually incomprehensible, inasmuch as violations of law and offenses against humanity were tacitly condoned."

It is no secret that the Catholic and Protestant clergy are joining hands in the persecution against the International Bible Students, both in America and other countries; not because they believe that the Bible Students are dis loyal to any government, but because exists against the Germans. The same ambition that the Bible, three thousand years ago, some of our members have sought to take advantage of the protection of the law, has been used as another means of persecution. Congress passed the elective Draft Act in May, 1917, and in that act provided that no person shall be compelled to engage in combatant military service who is a member of a well-recognized religious organization, the principles of which preclude its members from engaging in war. Thus the law makers of the land recognized that there are conscientious objectors who cannot conscientiously engage in mortal combat. The reason for this is that some have fully consecrated themselves to the Lord and they conscientiously believe if they are faithful to him they shall have a part in his Kingdom of righteousness, and that if they engage in the taking of human life this will destroy them eter-The law provides that such nally. shall be given non-combatant service.

"WIRELESS SEIZED"

About the same time that arrests vere being made in other places, the public press throughout the country announced that a "raid' had been made on the Bethel Home, Brooklyn, and a powerful wireless receiving station was found in the cellar and a sending station on the roof, intimating that this was maintained in the interest of pro-German work. The facts are these: Some three years ago, Mr. Edward of Pottstown, Pa., presented Pastor Russell with a receiving radio machine and it was erected on the roof of the Bethel Home. There never has been a sending apparatus about the premises; not even the receiver has been used, except to experiment with by some of the younger members who were trying to learn the operation of the wireless, and not even this has been done during the past two years. More than a year ago, the wireless was dismantled and the poles sawed up and used for other purposes, and the receiving instrument safely stored away in the art room. It was voluntarily produced and by consent removed, because we have no use for it. There is not a person about the Bethel Home, nor has there been for two years, who knows anything about the use of a wireless instrument.

that there was no transmitter connected with this instrument. The instrument was purely a receiving one. Messages could be received, but could not be sent. This was more or less between Pastor Russell and myself. Several of the residents there also knew of its presence. I know certainly when I presented the instrument to Pastor Russell that there was no one residing at the Bethel Home who could operate it intelligently. I was at the Bethel Home in August 1917, and I saw at that time that the aerial system was dismantled, the pole being sawed off even to the roof, but I did not see the instrument and was informed that the apparatus had been out of commission for over a year,

The sealing of wireless apparatus consists of taking down the aerial system and placing the apparatus where it would not be possible to use it. As near as I remember, the said receiving instrument has not been in use as a receiver for the last twenty months.

I have just now made a personal inspection of the instrument, which was taken from the Bethel Home on March 6th, 1918, and find that

the detector bulb upon which the success of the apparatus entirely depends is the original one I furnished in 1915, and is completely burned out, hence rendering the instrument of no practical use whatever. Twenty months ago I was asked to renew this said bulb by Mr. Crosby, but it was not renewed and has been out of commission ever since. In order to renew this bulb it would have been necessary to send the old one to the factory and procure a new one in its stead, this being the requirement of the manufacturer, De Forest Company. The De Forest Company have the patent on this bulb and they would not have renewed it without the return of the old one, and this was the original one I furnished. I found with the instrument a telegraph key, which was not a part of the said receiving set, being used to practice the code, as it is neces-

sary to know the telegraphic code before any one could intelligently receive or send a message. (Signed) EDW. A. KUSER,

C., and took the matter up with the Censor Committee of the Intelligence Section of the War Department. That Committee, after looking over the book, would not declare that any part of it is seditious, but advised that pages 247 to 253 be removed. Nearly all of the matter on these pages is quotations from two ministers of New York City, written prior to the United States' entry into the war, and who there discussed the advisability of war.
